



Lactation Management Courses

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El Certificado Profesional en Educador en Lactancia Materna es un ofrecimiento donde el/la estudiante tiene la oportunidad de estudiar completamente distancia los conceptos básicos en lactancia materna. Consta de tres cursos, divididos en 167 horas de educación en lactancia materna. El participante tendrá más de 200 horas de estudio y participación activa. Este programa está dirigido a médicos, enfermeras, nutricionistas y otros profesionales de la salud especializados en algún aspecto del cuidado perinatal, que provean atención a las madres o los infantes regularmente. También es un curso idóneo para otros profesionales o líderes de la comunidad que quiera mejorar sus destrezas para apoyar la lactancia. El programa se ofrecerá completamente a distancia usando el formato de Webinar y la plataforma Blackboard. Será uno interactivo en donde los participantes tendrán la oportunidad de intercambiar preguntas y puntos de vista con los conferenciantes y los otros estudiantes.

The “Certificado Profesional en Educador en Lactancia Materna” is a Spanish language offering wherein the student has the opportunity of studying by distance learning the basics concepts of breastfeeding. It consists of three courses, divided into 167 hours of breastfeeding education. The participant will have more than 200 hours of study and active participation. This program is intended for physicians, nurses, nutritionists and other health professionals specialized in some aspect of perinatal care who provide care for mothers and infants regularly. It is also an ideal course for other professionals or community leaders who want to improve their skills to support breastfeeding. The program is completely online using the webinar format and the Blackboard platform. It will be an interactive one where participants will have the opportunity to ask questions and exchange points of view with lecturers and other students.

Part 1: Breastfeeding and Public Health, includes many topics from Psychology, Sociology, and Anthropology; Ethical and Legal Issues; Research; Development and Nutrition, and Public Health Advocacy. Part 2: Clinical Breastfeeding Support covers topics including Physiology and Endocrinology; Pathology; Pharmacology and Toxicology; Techniques; and Clinical Lactation Skills.

NUTR 535: This course is an evidence-based introduction to medical lactation support including communication and counseling, local and global public health implications of breastfeeding, and current national and international legislation and policies. Professional responsibilities and practice components of becoming an International Board Certified Lactation Consultant are also covered as an introduction to working in the field of lactation.

NUTR 536: This course focuses on clinical breastfeeding care of the mother-infant dyad including challenges for the new mother, pregnancy, labor, and birth complications, breastfeeding initiation, management, and weaning, challenges for breastfeeding premature infants and multiples, and clinical management of breastfeeding issues.
